Brede Parish Council is looking to co-opt a Councillor. Could this be you?

What is the role of a Councillor?

- To represent the views of all residents within the Parish
- Improve the quality of life and the environment on the local area by identifying issues and bringing about improvements.
- To work in partnership with other councillors, parishes and agencies.

How much time does it take?

- Council meet formally 10 times a year (last Tuesday of the month except August and December).
- Additional Planning meetings are called when required.
- Councillors are also required to give time for other 'ad hoc' tasks or meetings assigned to them.
- Councillors will be expected to undertake New Councillor training plus any other relevant training.

Eligibility.

- You must be a UK, Commonwealth or EU citizen.
- You must be at least 18 years old.
- **AND EITHER**
- An elector of the parish, **or**
- Lived in the parish or within 3 miles for the past 12 months, **or**
- Owned land or property or worked in the Parish for the past 12 months
